### **Description Summary**

#### **(Full-time, Fixed-term 3 years)**

The National Drug Research Institute (NDRI) is a centre for excellence in alcohol and other drug research. NDRI, in collaboration with Monash University and the Australian National University, has been funded by the NHMRC to undertake a multidisciplinary study 'Understanding the barriers to improved access, engagement and retention of methamphetamine users in health services'. The project has a position available for a Research Associate or Research Fellow (depending on qualifications) for three years to coordinate and conduct the qualitative component of the project in consultation with the Project Leader.

The successful applicant will need to be able to work as part of team, but function effectively with minimal supervision. Tertiary qualifications, excellent oral and written communication skills, and experience in qualitative research are required.

The position will be located in the NDRI Melbourne office.
