ALCOHOL BASED SANITISER How much can I safely store?

Background

Areas around Curtin may be purchasing large quantities of hand sanitiser in preparation for the 2022 Academic year. These alcohol based products are highly flammable and are required to be stored in limited volumes to reduce the risk of fire.



Information

Unless stored in a dangerous goods cabinet or dangerous goods store the below volume limits apply to alcohol based sanitiser storage:

- Office areas: 10L per 50m² of floor space, or 5L for areas with <50m² of floor space.
- Workshops & Warehouses: 1L per 2m² of floor space with no more than 250L in any 500m² area.
- Laboratories: as per existing guidance in the Chemical Management Plan, section 10.
- All areas:
 - Storage areas of sanitiser in the same building must be separated by at least 20 metres (including when measured through internal walls).
 - O Do not count sanitiser bottles that are in-use towards these limits. But maintain the minimum practical number of bottles in-use in your area.

Key Messages

- Alcohol based sanitiser can only be stored in small amounts outside of a dedicated dangerous goods storage environment.
- Large amounts of alcohol based sanitiser is required to be stored in dedicated chemical / dangerous goods stores.
