

Go Global Airpods Giveaway – Terms and Conditions

- 1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
- 2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
- 3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
- 4. The competition is being run by Curtin University, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 ("Curtin University").
- 5. The Go Global Airpods Giveaway ("the competition") commences at 8am Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on Monday 28 February 2022.
- 6. The closing time for entering the competition is 11.59pm AWST on Wednesday 25 May 2022.
- 7. Entry to the competition is limited to students admitted in a course at a Western Australian campus (Curtin Perth Bentley, Curtin Perth City, Curtin Midland, and Curtin Kalgoorlie).
- 8. To enter the competition, the entrant must:
 - a) Subscribe online (https://students.curtin.edu.au/experience/global/) to learn about and agree to receive updates about Curtin Global Opportunities.
 - b) Competition entries will include current and new subscribers.
- 9. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
- 10. Entrants may only enter the competition once.
- 11. Staff employed by Curtin University are not eligible to enter the competition.
- 12. There will be one (1) prize. This prize will be a pair of Apple Airpods (2nd Generation).
- 13. There will be one (1) draw at 3pm Australian Western Standard Time on Friday 27 May 2022 at Curtin University Building 101. The draw will be by online name generator from all eligible entries received with the first entry drawn being the prize winner.
- 14. The prize winner will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw by the email address supplied by the entrant on the event registration form.
- 15. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within twenty-one (21) days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.

 Redraws will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.
- 16. If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner's parent or legal guardian.
- 17. The prize must be collected in person by the prize winner or parent/legal guardian.
- 18. If a prize winner who has been contacted and been made aware of their prize winning, and has agreed to collect the prize or for which collection is the only method for receiving the prize, does not collect the prize within twenty-one (21) days of this contact, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.
