

Curtin Open Day Competition 2025 – Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for the Curtin Open Day Competition 2025 (“the competition”) form part of these Terms and Conditions.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of the competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. The competition is being run by Curtin University, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 (“Curtin University”).
5. The competition opens at 9.00 am Australian Western Standard Time (“AWST”) on Friday, 21 February 2025.
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 3.00 pm AWST on Sunday, 6 April 2025.
7. To enter the competition, the entrant must:
 - a) register their contact details via the Curtin Open Day 2025 website (curtin.edu.au/open-day);
 - b) opt-in to receive further communications from Curtin; and
 - c) be available to collect the prize in person at the Curtin University Bentley campus during office hours of 8.30am – 4.30pm and within seven (7) working days following the prize draw.
8. All personal information collected in relation to the competition will be handled in accordance with Curtin University’s Privacy Statement (https://informationmanagement.curtin.edu.au/privacy/#Privacy_Statement).
9. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
10. Entrants may only enter the competition once.
11. Staff employed by Curtin University and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter the competition.
12. There will be seven (7) individual prizes.

13. Winners will be selected randomly using a random number generator using RANDOM.ORG from all eligible entries received. Winners will be notified within seven (7) days of the draw by the email address and/or mobile supplied by the entrant on the competition entry form.
14. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within seven (7) working days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within twenty-one (21) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method. Redraws will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.

15. If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner's parent or legal guardian.
16. The prize must be collected in person by the prize winner or parent/legal guardian from Curtin University Perth campus during office hours of 8.30am – 4.30pm within seven (7) working days of the prize draw.

If a prize winner who has been contacted and been made aware of their prize winning, and has agreed to collect the prize, does not collect the prize within seven working (7) days of this contact, a re-draw will be conducted within twenty-one (21) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.
18. The prize winner, or if under the age of 18 years their parent or legal guardian, may be required to provide evidence of their identity (such as photographic ID, birth certificate or current passport) when receiving the prize.
19. The prize winner will be responsible for all costs associated with collecting and using the prize.
20. By entering the competition, the entrant agrees that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.
