

Information

Inattention is now one of the leading behavioural causes of death and serious injury on our roads. A 2018 RAC survey found that <u>80 per cent of WA motorists use their phone</u> behind the wheel, despite 90 per cent admitting it was dangerous to do so.

Incident Details

There have been multiple recent incidents and near misses on campus involving vehicle – pedestrian collisions. The image above shows a member of the Curtin Community being struck by a slow moving car in one of our car parks. These occurrences are frequently at designated zebra crossings.


