

OASIS Prize Draw – Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
2. By entering this competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. This competition is being run by Curtin University, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 ("Curtin University").
5. The OASIS Prize Draw commences at 10:30 am Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on Wednesday, 7 August 2026.
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 11:59 pm AWST on Sunday, 26 July 2026.
7. Entry to the competition is limited to any current domestic and international student studying at Curtin University.
8. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older to enter the competition. Entrants under 18 years of age must obtain parent or legal guardian consent to enter the competition.
9. To enter the competition, entrants must complete the following steps between Monday, 13 July and Sunday, 26 July 2026.
 - a) Complete the online activity sent to their student email address
 - b) Submit before the closing time 11:59 pm AWST on Sunday, 26 July 2026.
10. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants are responsible for all other costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
11. Entrants may only enter the competition once.
12. Staff employed by Curtin University are not eligible to enter the competition.
13. There will be three (3) individual prize winners. Each prize winner will receive one (1) \$50 digital gift card from <https://www.prezzee.com.au>.
14. There will be one (1) prize draw at 10:30am AWST on Wednesday, 7 August 2026. Selection of prize recipients will occur via random draw. The final selection is contingent upon a review process designed to support equitable participation and diverse inclusion.
15. All prize winners will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw via the same email address used to contact them initially.
16. The prize will be sent via email to each prize winner.
17. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within twenty-one (21) days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method. Redraws will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.
18. All prize winners will be responsible for any costs associated with using the prize.
