

REDACTING YOUR IHI FROM YOUR VACCINATION CERTIFICATE

All COVID-19 vaccinations provided in Australia will be reported to the Australian Immunisation Register. Find the best way to get proof of your COVID-19 vaccination [here](#).

Evidence of acceptable vaccination documentation to the University will be a copy of your:

- COVID-19 digital vaccination certificate;
- Immunisation History Statement;
- International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate issued by the Commonwealth Government to the person showing the COVID-19 vaccination recorded on the Australian Immunisation Register; or
- Other evidence approved by the Chief Operating Officer or Provost (or their delegate).

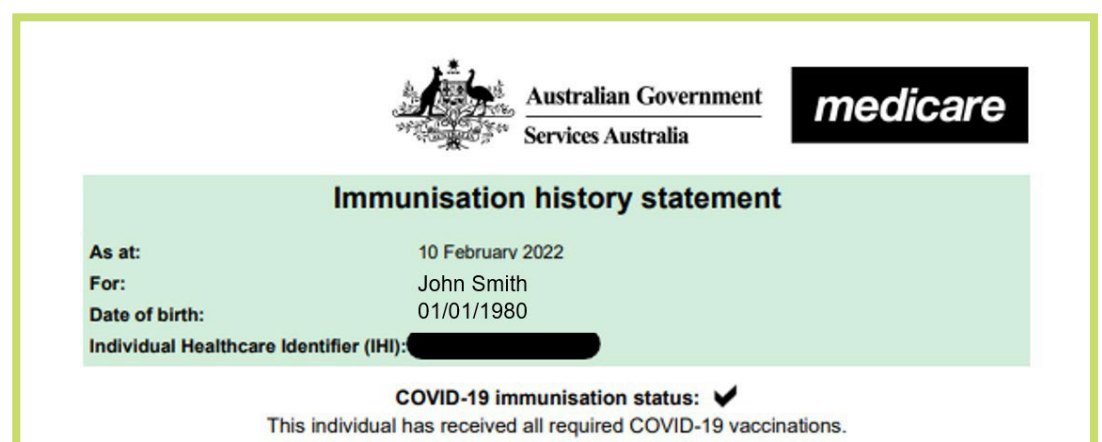
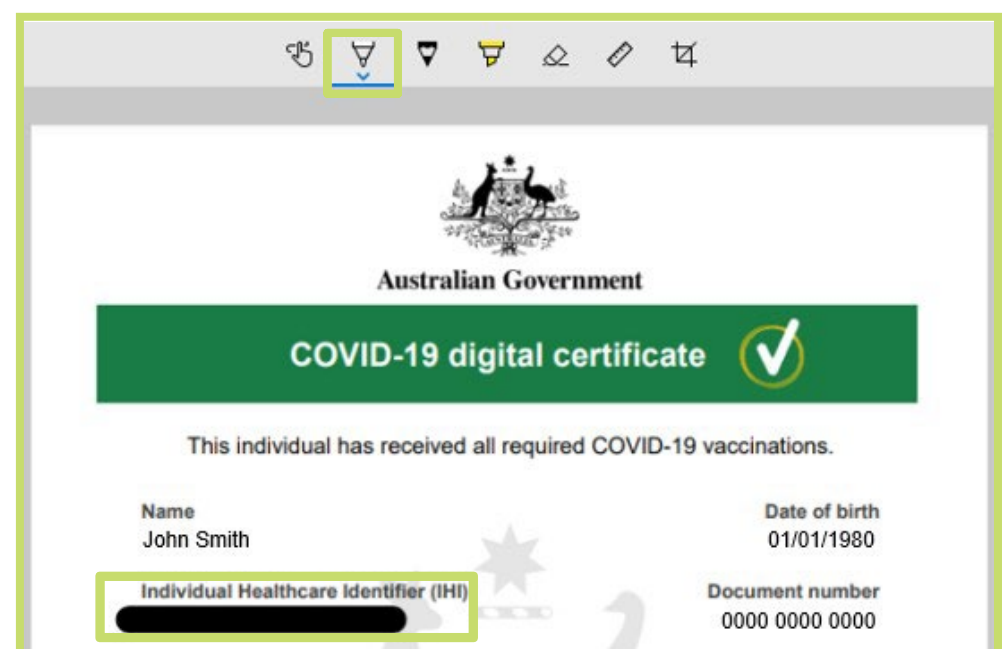
Some of these forms of evidence will contain your Individual Healthcare Identifier (**IHI**). Your IHI is very sensitive information, primarily used to assist healthcare providers in communicating and accessing records. **Curtin does not need to receive your IHI.**

In order to protect your personal information, we ask that you redact your IHI before uploading your proof of vaccination.

The PDF document you have downloaded will be locked for security purposes. As a result to redact your IHI you need to use the “Snip & Sketch” tool.

Use the tool to take a picture of your PDF document – you will then be able to use pen to redact your IHI as shown below. Save redacted version as a new copy.

If you are using your immunisation history statement as your proof of vaccination please also redact any irrelevant vaccinations from the record.
