



Feedback Hub prize draw – Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. The competition is being run by Curtin University, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 (“Curtin University”).
5. The Feedback Hub Online Activities Competition (“the competition”) commences at 8am Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on Thursday 23 July 2026.
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 12pm AWST on Friday 30 November 2026.
7. Entry to the competition is limited to Curtin University current students.
8. To enter the competition, the entrant must complete a weekly Feedback Hub Online Activity and include their student ID in the required field. For each week that they complete a Feedback Hub Online Activity, they will receive one (1) entry into the draw.
9. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
10. Entrants may only enter the competition once per week. They cannot complete the same Feedback Hub Online Activity twice.
11. Staff employed within the Engagement & Student Experience Team at Curtin University are not eligible to enter the competition.
12. There will be three (3) prizes. Each prize will be a \$100 Prezzy Gift Voucher.
13. There will be one (1) draw at 1pm Australian Western Standard Time on Wednesday 4 November 2026 at Building 502D, Curtin University, Kent St Bentley WA. The draw will be by RANDOM.ORG random sequence generator. Each entry will be assigned a number, and three (3) numbers will be returned as the prize winners.
14. The prize winners will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw via the Curtin email address associated with the student ID submitted via the online activity.
15. If the prize winner does not claim the prize within twenty-one (21) days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method. Redraws will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.
16. If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner’s parent or legal guardian.
17. The prize will be delivered via email to the prize winner.
18. The prize winner, or if under the age of 18 years their parent or legal guardian, may be required to provide evidence of their identity (such as photographic ID, birth certificate or current passport) when receiving the prize.
19. The prize winner will be responsible for all costs associated with collecting and using the prize.

20. By entering the competition the entrant agrees that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.
